



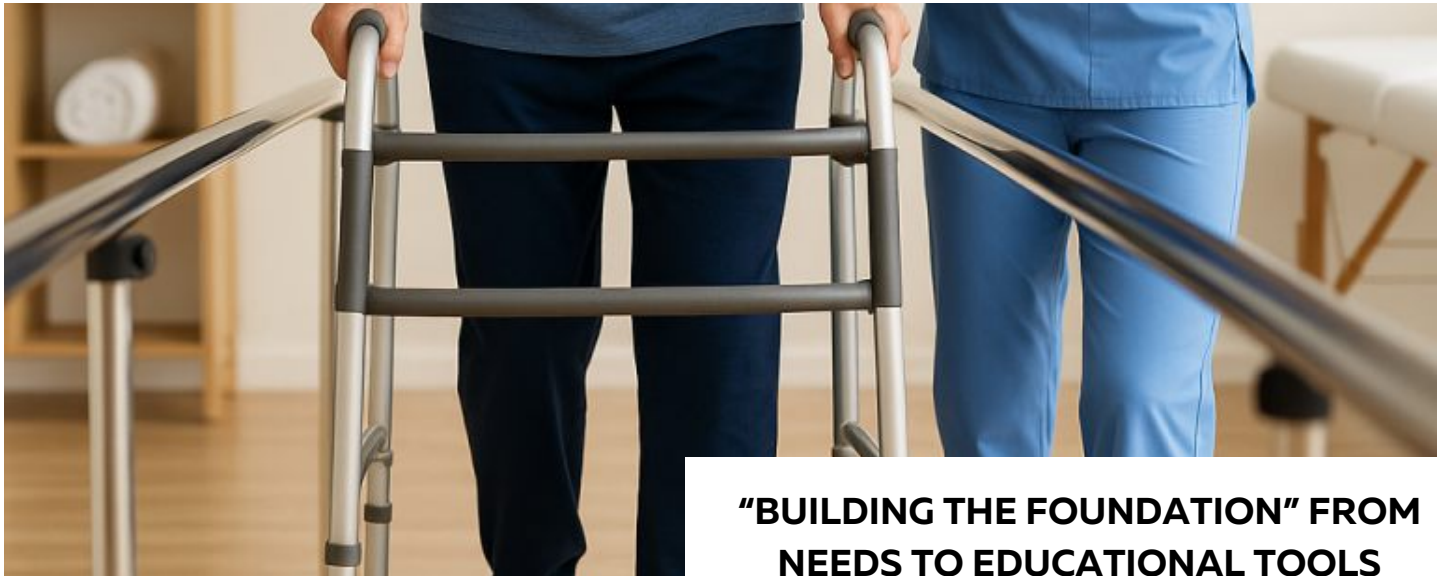

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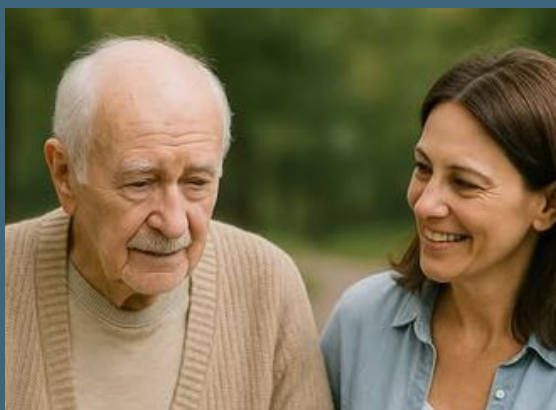
"BUILDING THE FOUNDATION" FROM NEEDS TO EDUCATIONAL TOOLS

PROJECT SUMMARY

With Europe's population aging rapidly, XR offers a sustainable, scalable way to enhance quality of life, reduce caregiver burden, and strengthen healthcare systems. Through the Gait-XR project, we are designing different tools that could support gait training and fall prevention for older adults with mild dementia.

The findings of the GAIT-XR needs assessment, with data from 101 questionnaires collected in all partner countries, reveal a critical alignment between professional experience and systemic gaps in training, education, and practical implementation of gait training for older adults, particularly those at risk of dementia.

By systematically analyzing those gaps across the partner countries, the assessment enables the project consortium to tailor the Gait-XR curriculum and training materials to the actual, context-specific needs of its target groups. In doing so, it sets a strong evidence-based foundation for the subsequent design and development of the XR training tool and the educational framework.
